

How to use compost?

Compost is a natural fertilizer and is very rich in nutrients. Mix it with soil before putting in to the plants.

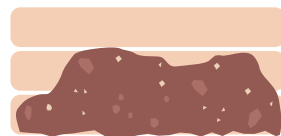
Mix "green with brown". Recommended ratio is 3:1 (carbonaceous brown materials:nitrogenous green materials).

Closed food loop



Harvest compost

Share the compost within your community. It takes approximately 6 months to harvest your first compost.



Compost maturation

Let the compost mature in the third chamber for at least 2 months.



Organisms are working here

The organisms like bacteria and fungi and worms are feeding on our foodscraps and turning them into compost.



Compost turning

Turn the first chamber into the second when it is full. At the same time turn the second chamber into the third (if applicable).
